WHAT DOES A DESIGN TRAINEE DO?

A Fire Sprinkler Design Trainee starts out surveying existing fire protection systems in the field, then focuses on acquiring knowledge in designing different types of automatic sprinkler systems, learning how to work with blueprints, digital design programs, preparing submittal packages for approval, and gaining an understanding of fire sprinkler and building codes.

HOW CAN A DESIGN TRAINEE ADVANCE?

A Fire Sprinkler Design Trainee can advance to a Sprinkler Designer after demonstrating the ability to independently create designs, perform calculations and fabricate lists. Pursuing additional training and NICET certification to strengthen their credentials is also recommended.

WHAT DOES A FIRE SPRINKLER DESIGNER DO?

FIRE SRINKLER DESIGNER

A Fire Sprinkler Designer is responsible for designing fire protection systems that meet NFPA 13 and local fire and building codes across industrial, commercial and residential settings. In addition to creating detailed designs, key duties include obtaining approvals and permits, calculating systems, adhering to allocated project hours and preparing documentation for design approval and job completion. Designers also conduct field surveys, assist with installation issues and manage final job close-out documents.

HOW CAN A SPRINKLER DESIGNER ADVANCE TO A MANAGER?

A Fire Sprinkler Designer can advance to a Manager after 5 or more years demonstrating proficiency in fire sprinkler system design, as well as fire code and building codes for a variety of building types. Managers also demonstrate excellent leadership skills and the ability to mentor and develop a team. Pursuit of NICET certification is also recommended.
