#### WHAT DOES A TRAINEE DO?

A Trainee assists with the installation and upkeep of fire sprinkler systems, involving pipe layout, sprinkler head attachment, and reporting safety concerns. The role requires adherence to safety protocols, cleanliness, and a contribution to jobsite safety and also learning proper tool management.

#### HOW CAN A TRAINEE ADVANCE TO A FITTER?

A Trainee can advance to a Fitter by gaining experience, pursuing additional training and obtaining certifications like NICET to strengthen their credentials.





#### WHAT DOES A FITTER DO?

This role involves installing sprinkler components, managing weekly paperwork, communicating about design changes or shortages, and creating red-line drawings. Regular communication with Field Superintendent and Project Manager, alongside training Fitters and Trainees, is required.

#### **HOW CAN A FITTER ADVANCE TO A** FOREMAN?

A Fitter's growth to Foreman relies on leadership skills, fire protection systems knowledge, and strong organizational abilities. It requires proactively managing installations, team coordination, timelines, and resources. Building relationships with clients and contractors is also vital.

#### WHAT DOES A FOREMAN DO?

A Foreman manages and coordinates fitters and technicians to complete projects efficiently, safely, and on budget. As experts in fire protection systems like sprinklers, alarms, and suppression systems, they interpret blueprints, devise project plans, and allocate resources effectively.

#### **HOW CAN A FOREMAN ADVANCE** THEIR CAREER?

Foremen can advance their careers by focusing on personal and professional development, expanding their knowledge and skills, and taking on additional responsibilities.



### WHAT DOES A SUPERINTENDENT DO?

A Superintendent maintains schedules, productivity and profitability of sprinkler/alarm system installation, service and inspection projects. This includes developing job schedules, hiring and supervising crews, coordinating material deliveries, managing labor hours and costs, conducting site visits and coordinating inspections. Superintendents are tasked with managing multiple projects and collaborating with the Project Manager and design team regarding project specifications, billings and change orders, and overall scope of the project.
